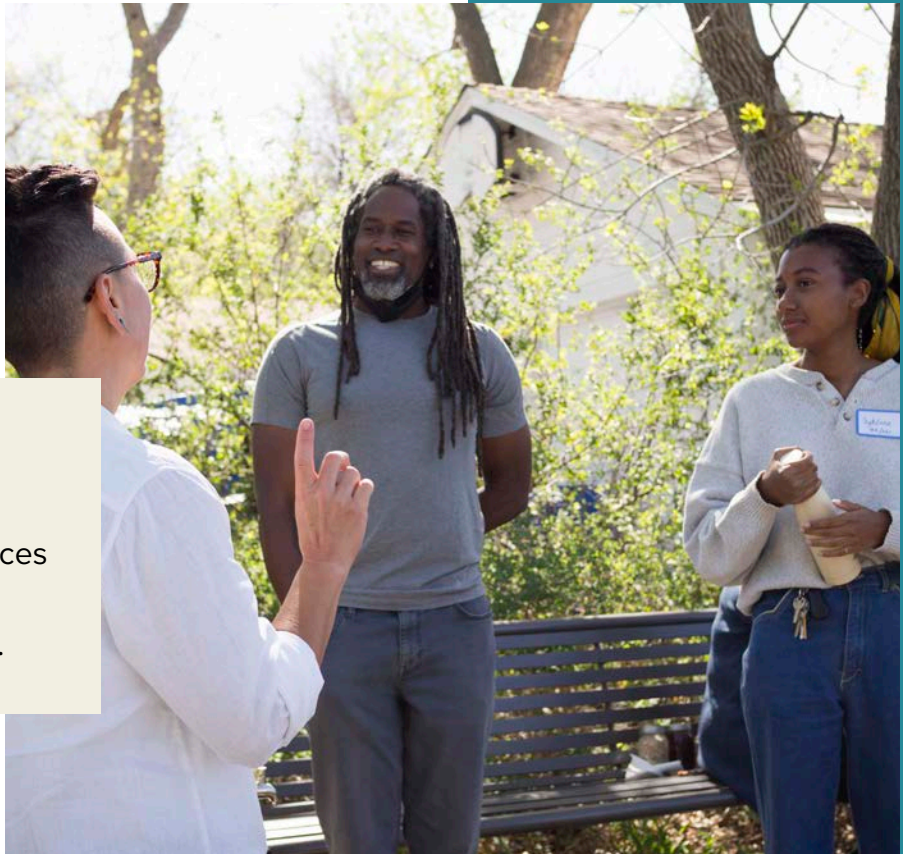

LETTER FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Chinook Fund Community,

Thirty-five years ago, a small group of activists and young people with wealth came together with a vision for a more just Colorado. **This vision would become the Chinook Fund, officially founded in 1987.**

The story starts in the winter of 1985 when Wendy Emrich, local activist, traveled to the California Bay Area and met with leaders at the Vanguard Public Foundation*, early members of the radical Funding Exchange. Wendy had long admired their work and soon partnered with fellow activist, Ginny Morgan, to convene a 13-person planning committee to bring their vision for social justice to life by building a Colorado-based progressive community fund. At the time, the state had a reputation for supporting far-right efforts and grassroots efforts were deeply in need of support.

LETTER FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



Chinook Fund would go on to make its first round of grants later that year, disbursing around \$40,000 to grassroots groups. While we come from humble roots, we have always dared to dream big.

Since 1987, we've distributed \$4.5 million to 554 organizations! Nearly 200 Giving Project members have raised over \$1M since launching the program in 2016. And, honoring our racial justice commitment, 92 percent of grantee groups were led by BIPOC communities this past year.

May we remember that organized communities are safer communities as we continue to be courageous and committed to the pursuit of justice and liberation.

THE GIVING PROJECT



The Giving Project is an innovative program for leadership development & social justice philanthropy. Over 6 months, we work closely with a diverse group of 25 people from all income levels who are passionate about social justice and want to strengthen their skills in fundraising, grantmaking, and grassroots organizing. They develop a shared analysis of race, class, and power within society, make a personal donation of an amount that is meaningful to them, then collectively raise and grant money to grassroots organizations working for social change in Colorado.

Giving Projects have been especially successful at reaching traditionally underrepresented communities, including young people and BIPOC leaders, in CO and throughout the US. We are proud to collaborate with 9 other community foundations across the country to develop this innovative model for social justice philanthropy and donor organizing.

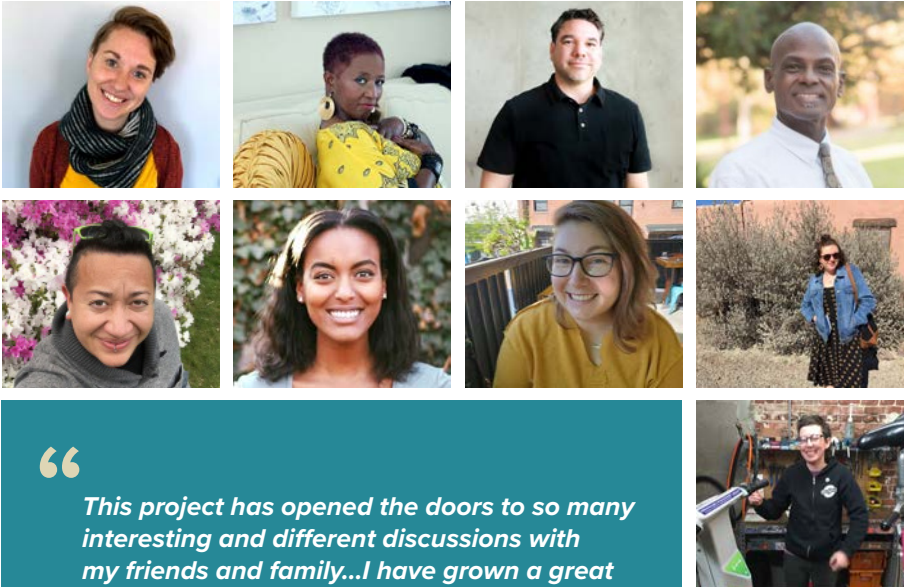

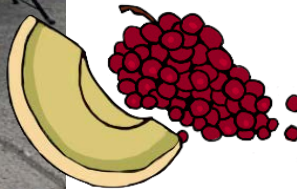

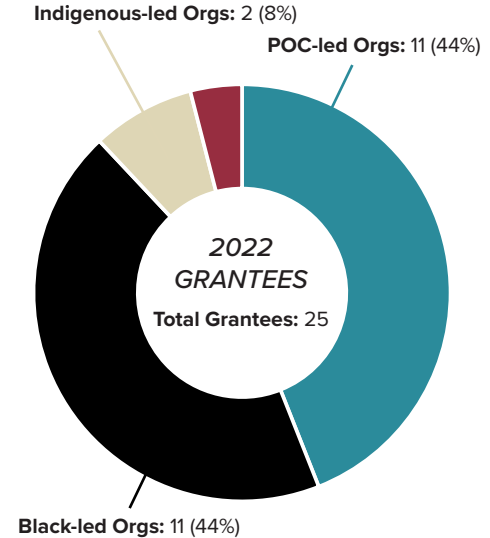
CORE FUNDING CRITERIA

Constituent-Led The work is led by the people most impacted by injustice.

Community-Wide The work reflects all members of the constituency, especially those who experience multiple forms of oppression.

Lasting Effect The work makes change not just for one individual today, but for the community as a whole, and for future generations.

Chinook Fund prioritizes funding BIPOC groups as part of our commitment to racial justice; such groups are chronically and systematically underfunded and under-resourced. In the Giving Project model, our racial justice framework centers **Black liberation and Indigenous sovereignty** given the realities that **all wealth in the U.S. is built on stolen land and stolen labor**. We are proud to support emerging and established BIPOC-led groups organizing for justice.

Spring 2022 - Another World is Possible Fund Grantee

People of the Sacred Land (PSL) is comprised of Native leaders, elders, and concerned citizens who want to learn the truth about the dispossession of their land and why Native people in Colorado were forced from their homelands.

PSL supports American Indian people to preserve their culture, language and ways of life that are intimately tied to the land. "Just like the wolves who are being returned to Colorado, we too would like to be able to be welcomed in our own land." -Rick Williams, PSL Executive Director

A start-up grantee, their first call to action, was to get a law rescinded that calls for Colorado citizens to kill hostile Indians and take their property. Their second immediate call to action was to establish a Truth and Reconciliation Commission (TREC) to study the conspiracy, genocide and fraudulent conveyance of Indian land in Colorado via the actions of the Fort Wise Treaty of 1861. This is an initiative that is led by the decedent's of the people who were violently removed from the area.

Currently, TREC is working on an Economic Loss Assessment and will use this report to develop restoration recommendations and educate the Colorado Community.

Another Life Foundation, founded in 2004, offers services to individuals battling with mental illness and suicidal behaviors. Their mission is to promote wellness, empowerment, and support to save lives and reduce suicidal behaviors by educating the public, raising awareness, providing support, and advocating for health equity policies that affect people with mental illness. Another Life Foundation is a peer-led community organization, whose members have come together to support, educate, and empower those in the community living with a mental illness.

A few of their recent activities include:

Launch of “The Black Youth Project” in 2021 in collaboration with SimsFayola in Denver. This project is focused on bringing awareness and stressing the importance of mental wellness, among Black youth in the community. Another Life Foundation presents four 30-minute wellness seminars over zoom each year. Each seminar features Black male speakers. These speakers have a lively discussion with Black youths about the importance of mental wellness and seeking help if help is needed. Thriveworks Counseling has come aboard to offer counseling and/or therapy sessions for the youth.

Launch of “The Mahogany Project” in 2021 in collaboration with KeyBank4women. The Mahogany Project is dedicated to supporting, educating, empowering, and advancing economic and social equality for women and girls of color. The project offers financial, economic, and entrepreneurship workshops, as well as wellness, self-care, and empowerment education. Another Life Foundation presents six workshops a year. Each workshop features different entrepreneurs from the community. These entrepreneurs offer business tips and advice to achieving financial wellness. Mental and physical wellness resources are also made available.

The mission of the El Alba Catering Services Cooperative Project (El Alba) is to build a business cooperative, owned and operated by immigrant and refugee entrepreneurs in North Aurora, that supports community wealth building and economic stability, as well as advancing values of empowerment, worker dignity, and a holistic support for the social health of the community as a whole.

Since El Alba formed, a steering committee has met regularly to carry out business functions, provide services and money-generating opportunities to its members, and fundraise for the build-out of the commissary kitchen.

Milestones Include:

- Formally obtained cooperative corporation status through the State of Colorado as of September 2020
- An established co-op of nine members
- Held cooperative training with expert facilitators
- Created a business plan with the help of the Small Business Development Center that includes a market analysis, industry trends, competitor analysis, and environmental scans
- Raised \$180,000 (55% of goal) through private foundations towards capital expenses for kitchen build-out
- Purchased an El Alba food truck that continues to provide money-generating opportunities for members
- Established partnerships with Village Exchange/ Village Farms and East Denver Food Hub to source food products for members
- Effective lobbying for land use opportunities within North Aurora that will benefit future members through permanent food truck hubs and open-air markets

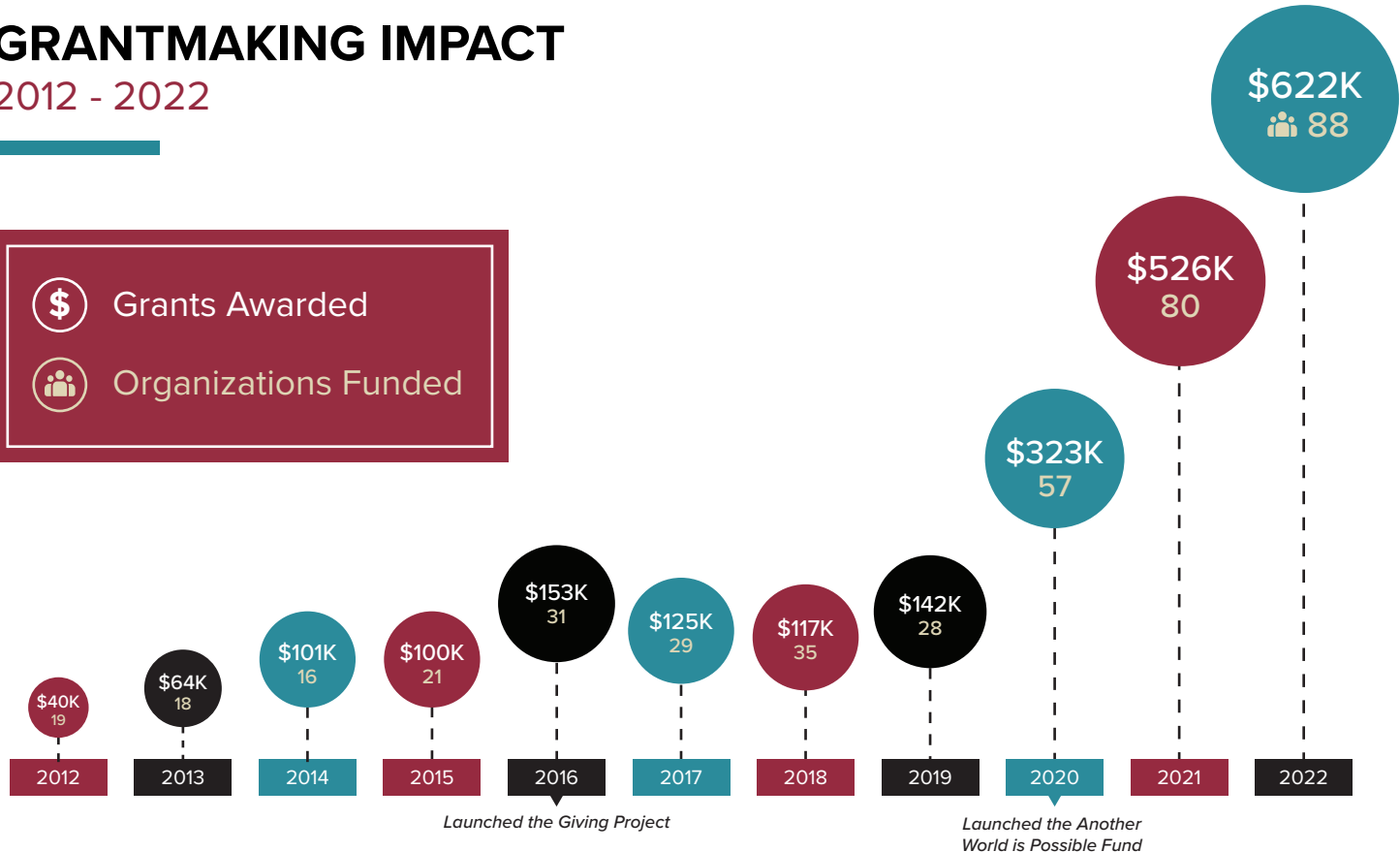
El Alba is now in its final phase of start-up, which will conclude when all needed funds are secured for the commissary kitchen. COVID-19 presented unforeseen challenges that impacted the timeline of the project. Fundraising and construction were delayed by about a year but progress has now resumed.

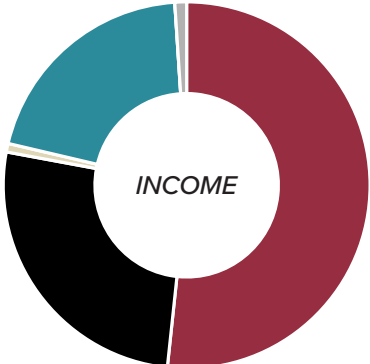

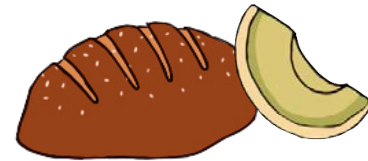
